Achieve



Aspire

Write 3 Tweets that summarises what life was like for King Henry V111.

No more than 140 characters; use #'s for key words and they must be informative.

Put together an emergency kit full of items that would be needed after a hurricane.

Take a photo or draw and label the items on a piece of paper/ card.

Create a poster on one of the six main world religions (Christianity, Hinduism, Islam, Sikhism, Buddhism and Judaism)

Use any key terms you have learned, make it informative and eye catching. Make sure you include their religious symbol and key beliefs.

Use the internet to research the sort of food that Medieval people ate.

Ensure it includes how people currently treat the earth, what can be done to slow climate change and why it is important to act now.

Design and build a historically accurate model of a castle out of cake (or on minecraft)

Include all of the features of a castle i.e. Motte, Bailey, Keep etc.

Imagine you are a doctor being sent to work in an earthquake torn country. Produce a list of essential items you will take with you.

Then, write a series of diary entries to describe what you see while you are working.
