At present there are 260 students on roll across the whole school, which will increase to approx. 300 students across both the Main School (including Maplewell Autism Provision (MAP) and our Post 16 Site, based in Loughborough, from Autumn 21.

MAP supports and provides learning for students with high functioning Autism and is designed for students to reach and achieve their full potential. Our Post 16 Site aims to provide all our students with a pathway to employability.

This is a fantastic opportunity for proactive individuals who have the ability to apply support strategies where barriers to learning present themselves. You will be able to communicate

effectively and have an understanding of the support needs of an individual student within education.
