After the death of Queen Elizabeth II, some of our students decided to create some artwork to commemorate her. Students and staff were invited to draw a picture of the Queen or something that reminded them of her, for example her corgis. These were collated together to create a silhouette of the Queen, reminiscent of the postage stamp image. Students from 8MSS also worked together to paint the Queen, using a technique where the original image was broken down into coloured shapes, a little like paint by number. Both pieces are currently displayed in the reception area of the main school.


Students also had the opportunity to visit shops and had some chips by the sea, supporting their independent living skills.
