GCSE History- Paper 1

The exam consists of two papers, each with two sections:

Paper 1: Understanding the Modern World

Section A: Period studies- AB Germany, 1890–1945: Democracy and dictatorship

Six compulsory questions

Section B: Wider world depth studies- <u>BB Conflict and tension: The inter-war years, 1918–1939</u>

Four compulsory questions

GCSE History- Paper 2

Paper 2: Shaping the Nation

Section A: Thematic studies- AA Britain: Health and the people: c1000 to the present day

Four compulsory questions

Section B: British depth studies (including historic environment)- BC Elizabethan England, c1568–1603
